

SAFETY RULES AT THE VISTULA UNIVERSITY DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC

1. Only a healthy person, without symptoms suggesting an infectious disease, who has not been in direct contact with somebody infected with COVID-19, is not under quarantine, epidemiological supervision or home isolation, may enter the University.
2. When entering the University premises, each person is obliged to disinfect the hands with liquid based on min. 70% alcohol, located at the entrance to the main hall and at the entrances from the underground garage.
3. During your stay at the University you should:
 - cover your mouth and nose with a mask;
 - limit personal contacts between other people and keep the required distance (at least 1.5 m), also during classes;
 - regularly wash and disinfect your hands, using dispensers located in many places at the University;
 - not use the lifts, unless it is necessary for health reasons (in this case, maximum 2 people can stay in the lift, keeping the required distance of 1.5 m);
 - follow the recommendations regarding the limited number of people in lecture halls and toilets (according to the information on the door).
4. Before each class, air the room, fill in the attendance list (name and surname, album number) and return it to the teacher.
5. After completing classes in computer rooms and other laboratories - when leaving the workplace - each student is obliged to wipe the used surfaces with a disinfectant.
6. The stay of students on the University campus is limited only to situations resulting from participation in compulsory classes, visits to the library (www.vistula.edu.pl/en/students/library) and to individual cases requiring direct contact between students and University employees (after prior appointment by phone or via e-mail).
8. If a student develops symptoms of COVID-19 infection, he or she should stay at home and inform the medical services (GP) of this fact, or contact the Epidemiological Station (22 2500 115, koronawirus@pssewawa.pl). You can also call the **Telephone Patient Information (800-190-590, for English press 2) where you will get information how to deal with suspected coronavirus infection.** If sent to quarantine, each student is obliged to notify the University (m.iasinski@vistula.edu.pl and rektorat@vistula.edu.pl or rektorat.sgtih@vistula.edu.pl).
9. In the event of a suspected COVID-19 infection during the stay at the University, the student should notify the teacher, who is obliged to follow the applicable procedures
