

## **Procedure for the mobility of Vistula School of Hospitality students and employees under the Erasmus + Program during the COVID-19 pandemic**

Before making a final decision regarding each mobility, it is necessary to consider the purposefulness of the trip and the possibility of achieving the assumed goals, as well as all circumstances resulting from the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic, in particular:

1. Current recommendations of the Chief Sanitary Inspector, the Ministry of Science and Higher Education, the National Agency of Erasmus + Program, the Foundation for the Development of the Education System (FRSE);
2. Possible difficulties in returning to Poland, air traffic restrictions, the obligation to undergo quarantine or self-isolation, or the need to present a document confirming the coronavirus test result and other recommendations of local authorities;
3. Possible financial consequences resulting from cancelling the trip and prolonged forced stay at the destination;
4. The necessity to have an appropriate insurance policy for travel and stay that is the responsibility of the mobility program participant;
5. The mobility program participant undertakes to comply with the security procedures and guidelines / recommendations received from the partner institution in which he / she will stay;
6. In the event of the program participant showing symptoms of COVID-19 infection, he / she should remain in the place of stay and inform the coordinators of this fact both at the partner institution and at the home university.
